Field Dates: February 20-23, 2026


**N=1000 car owners who are also registered voters**

# Key findings

- There continues to be near universal agreement about the premise statements for the SMART Act and the REPAIR Act.
  - 94% of car owners agree it is important to them to be able to choose who repairs their car.
  - 99% of car owners agree it is important to them to be able to choose where their car is repaired.
- After a brief description, support among car owners for the SMART ACT is at 79%.
  - This includes strong support from demographic groups ranging from Trump voters (82%) to liberal Democrats (78%).
- Fully 85% of car owners support the REPAIR Act after hearing a brief description of the legislation.
  - This includes strong support from Trump voters (85%) and Harris voters (86%).


# VIEWS ON VEHICLE REPAIRS

It is important to me to be able to choose who repairs my car




# VIEWS ON VEHICLE REPAIRS


- **80% states with 55%+ vote for Trump in 2024**
